
What's happening in Year 4 this half term Autumn 1 2023

English

Within our English sessions we will be exploring the text 'The Egyptian Cinderella'.



We are discussing expanded noun phrases, fronted adverbials, speech and possessive apostrophes.

How to help your child

Talk about what your child wants to write.
Encourage your child to remember punctation.
Learn how to spell common exception words eg because, would, could, who (see list)
Work on letter formation
Work on handwriting

Subjects

Science

We will be investigating 'Living things and their habitats'.

History

This half term we are learning about historical events, focusing on 'Ancient Egypt'.

Design Technology

We are learning about levers and linkages to create an interactive book.

Religious Education

We are learning about Christianity and considering if people need to go to Church to show they are a good Christian?

Personal Development

We are learning about being ourselves and rights and responsibilities.

Music
